By popular demand, we are again offering classes using the wonderful PEERS curricula from UCLA. This evidence-based program was specifically designed for teens and young adults, focusing on the typical interactions these students have with their peers. We love these curricula because they are 'real' – how to informally greet someone with a "S'up?", how to tell jokes, how to enter and leave a conversation, and much more. In short, it's the equivalent of 'conversational social skills' as opposed to 'textbook social skills' – how young people actually interact.

The course is 14 weeks long and has a parent component to scaffold the work the teens and young adults are doing. We will be conducting the parenting component via webinar to make it easier for busy parents to attend sessions or view missed sessions at a later date.
