CollegeLaunch

Semi-Supported College Experience

Now starting its 4th year, this program supports neurodivergent high school graduates (ADHD, mild learning differences, low-need autism, mood challenges) transition from high school to college life and adulthood. This program runs June through May to support the full academic calendar.

Who is this Program For?

- 1) All or mostly mainstreamed neurodivergent students in high school programming, graduating with a diploma in June 2025.
- 2) Students interested in attending college either for a two- or four-year degree OR interested in post-secondary programming for Career Technical Education certification.
- 3) Students willing to commit to a 12 month program, which includes weekly 1:1 and group meetings through the full year.

What Does the Program Contain?

- 1) Independent Living Skills instruction
- 2) Career and field of study selection
- 3) Accommodation and registration training and support
- 4) Academic success support and exam preparation
- 5) Executive functioning training and support
- 6) Pre-employment skills including support on internships and volunteering, and training on self-advocacy, job qualifications, job applications and interviewing
- 7) Social activities online and training on how to engage with peers locally

What does the program cost?

This program is valued at \$18,000/year and offered at a discounted rate of \$10,000 (paid in full by 5/1/25) for the full year with autopay plans available for \$1,000/month. There will be additional costs of \$20-25 for each of the workbooks with the materials for the group class curriculum.

What Are the Requirements for Participants?

We strongly encourage participants to attend our LifeLaunch program over summer in person in our office. If not feasible to attend in office, a remote option will be available. Please see LifeLaunch flyer for dates and details.

What Are the Limitations for Participants?

We do not advise participating in other programming such as a TPP or other transition programming simultaneously. We ask that participants fully commit throughout the year long program.

How Do I Enroll?

All applicants must fill out our application form and send it in by the application deadline listed below. Once we receive it, we will conduct an interview with each applicant to determine goodness of fit for the program.
